Patrol Corners

Run by SPL or ASPL

- · Attendance is taken by patrol scribe or APL
- Uniform inspection completed by APL
- PL reviews any troop messages
- Prepare for upcoming campout (menu, grocery planning, duty roster)
- Informs patrol of upcoming patrol meeting
- Discuss issues that need to be addressed at a future PLC

Skill Instruction

Run by Troop Guide and Senior Leaders

- Instructors/Guides teach chosen skill using EDGE method
- Possibly split to smaller groups to maintain order and involvement
- Make sure all scouts get involved

Activity/Game

- Game should create patrol competition
- Reinforce the skill that was taught
